The event took place at the **4 stars hotel Castilla-Termal Olmedo.** The participants were welcome at the conference room, they signed the attendance register and got a folder with the programme, a leaflet of the **Cepa de Olmedo** and a USB with logos of WAAT and Cepa de Olmedo.

The conference started with a welcome from the director of the Adult Education

Center, Mr. Álvaro García Prieto, followed by the chief of Educational Programs of the Education Department of the regional government (Junta de Castilla y León), Mr. Victor González Fernández, who talked about the importance of internationalization of the educational centers and Erasmus+ projects.
